Room at the Inn provides immediate, temporary shelter to homeless women and families in the St. Louis region. In addition, Room at the Inn works with the clients to create an individualized plan back to self-sufficiency, including referrals to other human services agencies. The Shelter uses a collaborative, interfaith effort of nearly 60 congregations (we are one of three Jewish congregations to participate) and organizations in the St. Louis Region to accomplish this goal. Each night, Room at the Inn guests are invited to a different organization, where they are provided with dinner, sleeping facilities, breakfast, companionship and transportation to and from the Day Shelter in Bridgeton. Up until Covid-19, Shaare Emeth hosted 10 people from Room at the Inn on the first Monday of the month.

However, during the last 7 months, the clients have been housed at the Room at the Inn Site in Bridgeton. If you brought items to donate, many thanks to you and your family.
